School name or postcode

Children will be given their logon when they start at Newhall Junior. This will be kept in their reading diary. Children can access TTRockstars through the internet browser. You must first find the school and then log in using their details.

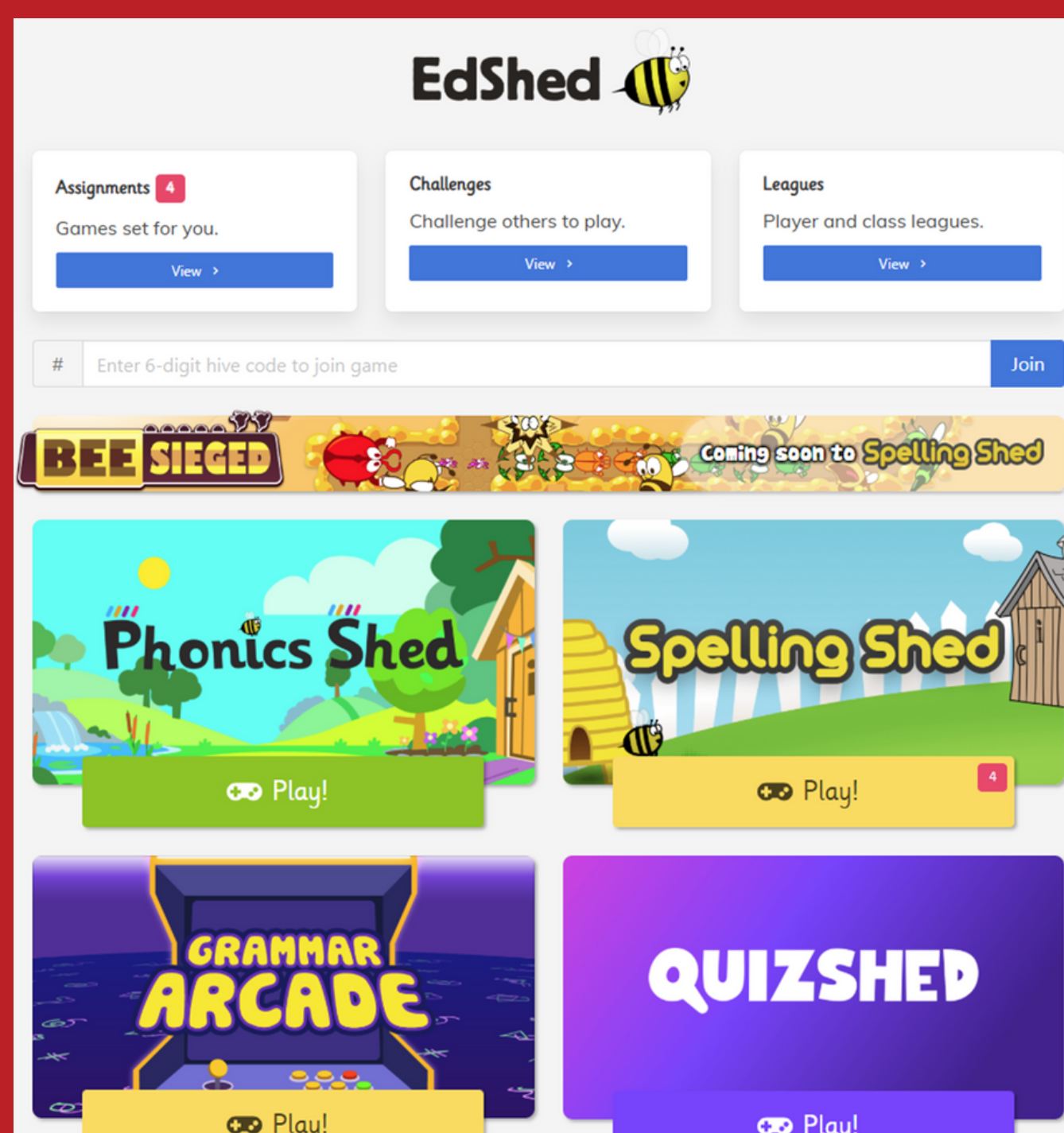

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When you go into assignments, you may see multiple sets of spellings. Children will just practice the words that are in their stage.

If your child's set is not there, you can search through the lists. This will also be good for recapping to support children's long term memory.

Star Reading

At school, children will complete a Star Reading Test which will tell them which ZPD they can read from the library. During the school day, children will be able to quiz through the Accelerated Reader tab but this can also be done at home. Encourage children to use the book to help them answer the questions.

When you have clicked Accelerated Reader, type in either the book name or code from the inside cover. This will take children to the quiz for them to complete.

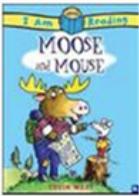

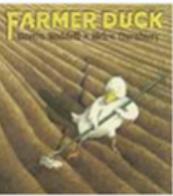

Beehive



HOW TO ACCESS BEEHIVE

Students and parents can access Beehive via smartphone app (see links below) or via the website:

 <https://beehive.lionhearttrust.org.uk>

To do this simply go to the website and click on the activate button.

1. Enter your email address previously provided to the school.
2. An activation link will be sent to your email address.
3. The link will return you to Beehive. Where you will need to confirm some details* for security and choose a password..
4. You can then log in to Beehive.

Once a parent has one Beehive account you will be able to see all of your children in the same account even if they are at different schools in the Trust.

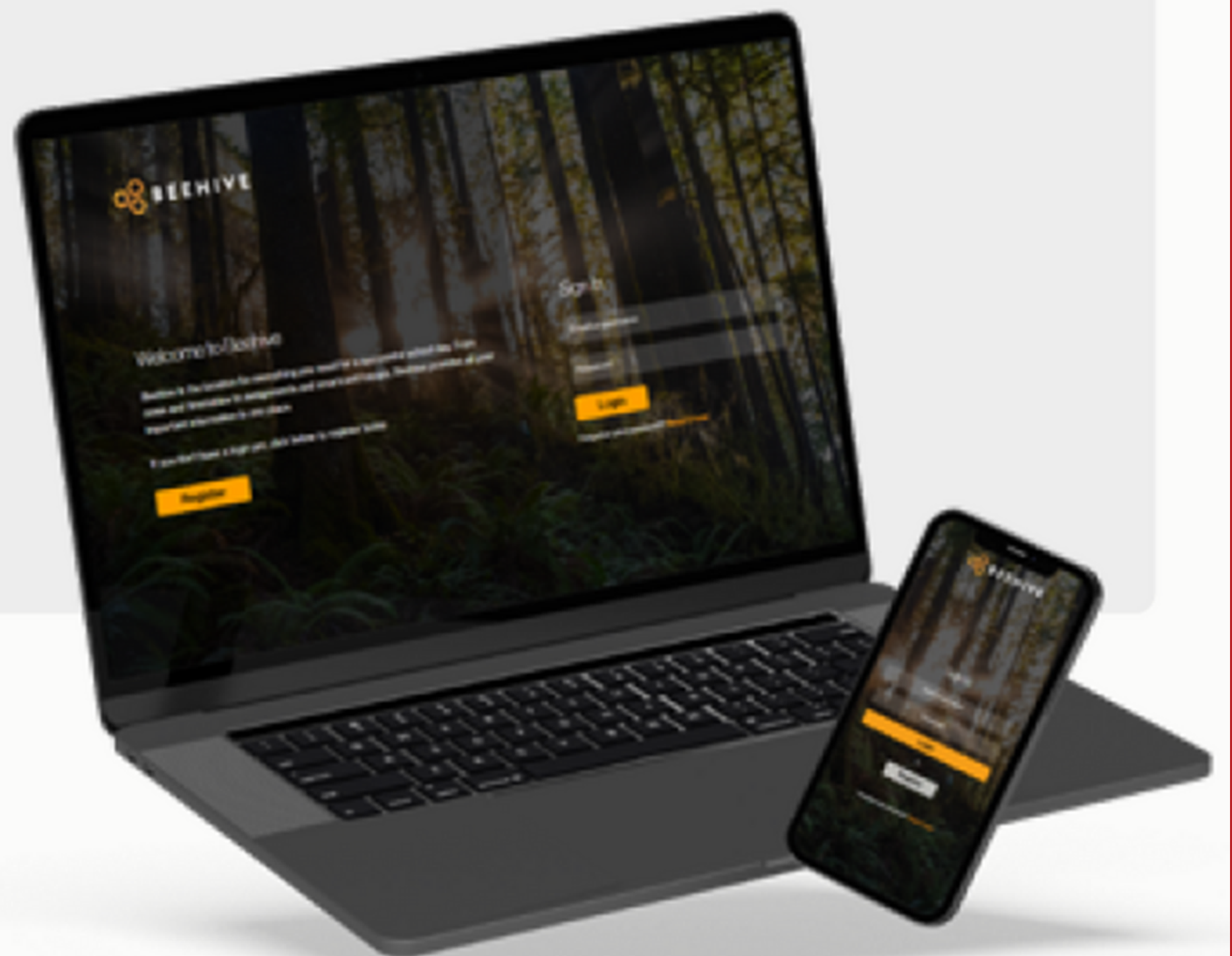

CONSENT

Parents/carers can set consent for use of images in the media and marketing materials, as well as how their child's data is used in school to celebrate achievements.



MAILOUT

Email communication to parents/carers. This system will also allow parents/carers to view letter archives. When documents (reports, exam timetables) are available to view in Beehive, you will receive an email notification via mailout.



EVENTS

Available only for students, but useful for parents/carers to know, the events module shows a planned schedule of after school events. Students can sign-up to extra-curricular activities and parents/carers will be informed of any changes to events automatically.



PAY & STORE

Parents/carers have the ability to top-up their child's smart card with credit for use at break and/or lunchtime. Parents/carers can see a breakdown of spend per day and keep track of the credit balance. This module is also used to pay for products and trips.



BEHAVIOUR

Allows staff to instantly give reward and behaviour points, with parents/carers automatically informed of detentions via email and SMS. Parents can view their child's attendance and see reward and behaviour points given. Clicking on the reward/behaviour points will offer details on why it was issued.



Beehive is a parent/career tool that links parents/careers to the school. You will be able to see what is going on in school, pay for trips and lunch and much more. Please use the email that you gave to school for your login as this will sync your child's details across.

As a school, we use the positive side of behaviour. You will be able to see when your child receives Beehive points linked to our 6Rs.
